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PREFACE

Tony passed away in September 2017, shortly after completing this book. We, his family, are proud of what he has achieved with these puzzles, especially his determination to finish them during the last few months of his life. After he retired from teaching, Tony dedicated many hours to compiling puzzles, both in this and his previous books.

When he entered the teaching profession, Tony started constructing Bible puzzles to show the children that the Bible is not a dry, dusty book to be read only in churches and chapels. These puzzles have been compiled to show how people worked, lived and died in the Middle East over 2,000 years ago. They show a region covered in mountains, rivers, deserts and farmland. They illustrate the diversity of wildlife as well as the different kinds of work people did. The Bible is full of stories of great battles in which many thousands were killed and hardships were endured, and of long journeys that were undertaken, such as the Israelites' exodus from Egypt to their final destination in Moab, which took 40 years to complete.

When reviewing other Bible puzzles, Tony realised they often contained a lot of material that had nothing to do with the Bible. He ensured that his puzzles do not contain any such padding. Therefore, the clues to the puzzles in this book are accompanied by a reference to where it can be found in the Bible.

The Bible is not one book but many; in modern translations, it contains over 31,000 verses, all of which have a reference number. As these puzzles are meant to inform as well as entertain, it is useful to have a Bible to hand to help solve them (see the note on the Bible versions used for this book on page 9).

We hope you will obtain as much pleasure in solving these puzzles as Tony did in researching and constructing them. Good luck!

A NOTE ON BIBLE TRANSLATIONS

There are numerous English translations of the Bible. Most of the answers to the puzzles in this book use the vocabulary and spelling of the latest edition of the New International Version (NIV), one of the most widely used translations. Although other versions will usually give the same answer, in some cases there are significant differences, particularly with the spelling of certain names and places and with the identification of animals and gemstones.

If an answer uses a word or variant spelling other than that found in the NIV, then the clue will indicate another translation where the correct answer can be found. This will either be the New Revised Standard Version (NRSV) or the King James Version (KJV).

Different translations of the same Bible verse are available free online (e.g. on websites such as **biblegateway.com**). If you are still stuck, then as a last resort you can always look up the answers at the back of the book (starting on page 140).






